50g Digestive biscuits (4 biscuits) 100g Chocolate (dark, milk or white, or dairy free) 2 tsp milk/ dairy free alternative 25g (about 2 tablespoons) butter / dairy free alternative 25g (about 3 tablespoons) icing sugar Cocoa/ coloured fondant icing/ white chocolate to decorate.
